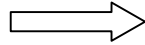

Logic Model**

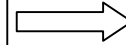

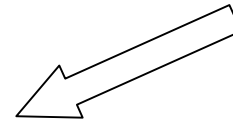

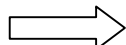

**OUTCOMES**

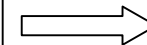
**INITIAL**

- Increase knowledge of individuals, families and the community regarding what protects children from substance abuse.



**INTERMEDIATE**

- Middle and High School aged youth demonstrate improved self-control.
- Families develop clear rules and boundaries for their children
- Middle and High School aged youths' view of themselves as resources is increased



**LONGER-TERM**

- Youth will reduce their risk taking behavior including substance abuse
